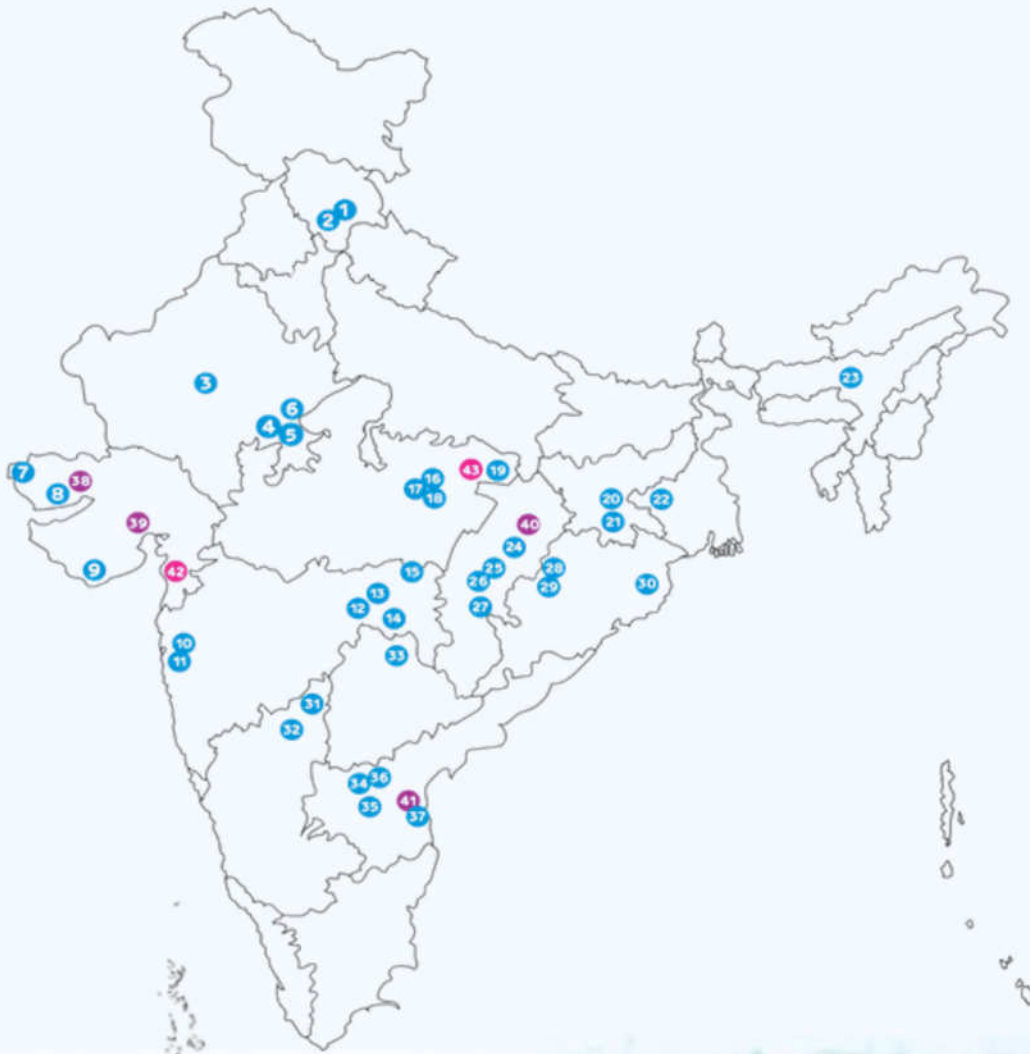

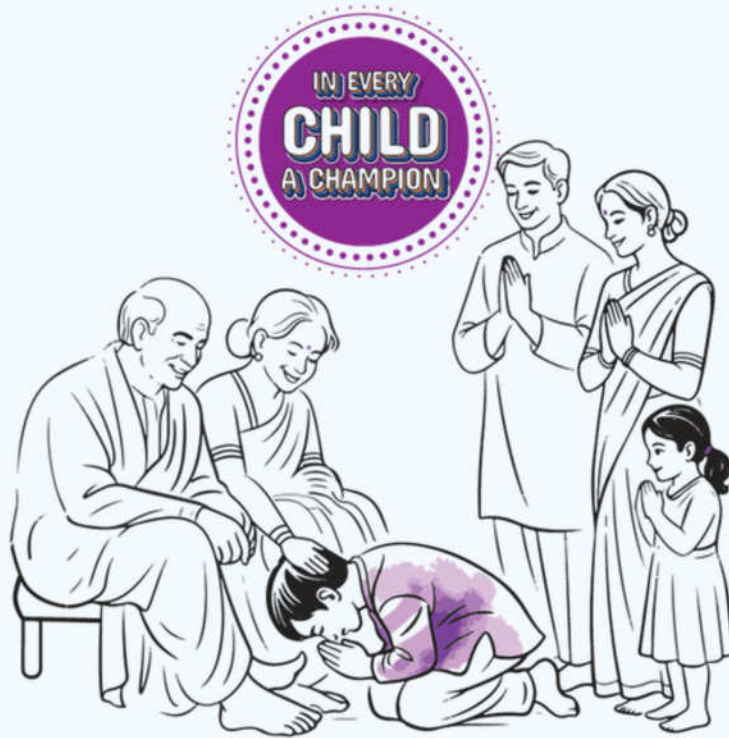

Featured in Inclusionista | A Global Recognition

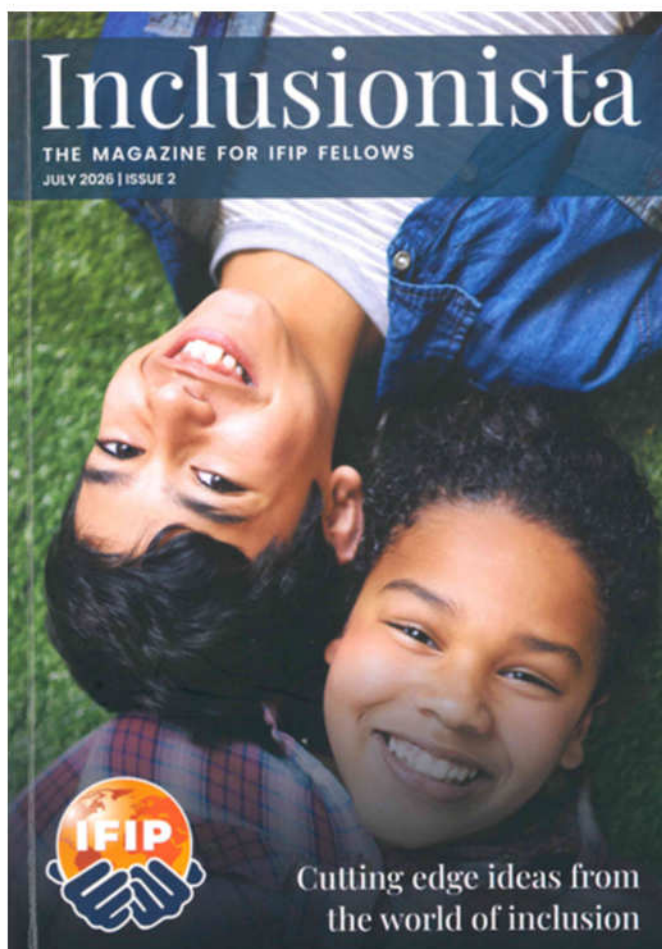
Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad, has taken its commitment to inclusive education to a global platform.

It is about a belief that every learner deserves to be seen, valued, supported and empowered to thrive.

From access to opportunity, from diversity to strength, AVMA continues to show what education can become when inclusion is not merely a programme, but a way of thinking and living.





FROM UNCERTAINTY TO UNSTOPPABLE

THE AVMA STORY OF BELONGING, GROWTH, AND POSSIBILITY

In the corridors of Adani Vidya Mandir Ahmedabad, inclusion is not a programme, a policy, or a carefully curated statement displayed on a wall. It is a lived experience. It is the quiet assurance with which every child walks through the school gates knowing they are seen, valued, and welcomed exactly as they are.

I am Dr Shilpa Indoria, the head of a school which has more possibilities than limitations. I joined Adani Vidya Mandir, doubting the abilities

of these children who belonged to the underserved communities with no technical, digital and literacy support at home. On one hand though these children were emerging as the first literates and professionals of their families, on the other hand they had to surmount the emotional upheavals of their life. The journey was difficult but not impossible. With a firm belief that every learner carries within them immense potential waiting to be discovered I built an inclusive environment where each child was nurtured, and empowered. Today, in my school, children are not defined by their limitations, language barriers, socio-economic backgrounds, or the circumstances they come from. Instead, they are encouraged to take ownership of their own learning journeys and find their voice within a compassionate ecosystem rooted in belonging, emotional safety, and human connection.

I believe inclusion begins the moment a child stops asking, 'Do I belong here?' and starts believing, 'This is where I can become who I am meant to be.'

One such story is that of **Dhruvisha Vaia**.

There are some journeys that begin not with confidence, but with courage.

In 2015, a quiet young girl named Dhruvisha Vaia walked into Adani Vidya Mandir Ahmedabad carrying little more than hope in her eyes and determination in her heart. Having studied in a Gujarati medium school, she struggled through the admission aptitude test and barely qualified.

But we at Adani Vidya Mandir did not see a score.

We saw a possibility.

More Than Admission – An Embrace

For many schools, admissions are about selecting the 'best fit.' At Adani Vidya Mandir, it is about ensuring every child finds where they belong.

Dhruvisha came from a modest home where dreams often had to negotiate with reality. Her father worked at a petrol station later transitioning to a Municipality worker driving the garbage pick-up vans, and her mother served as a housemaid. Financial limitations shadowed the family, but never once did they diminish her hunger to learn.

What she needed was not sympathy.

She needed someone to believe she could soar.

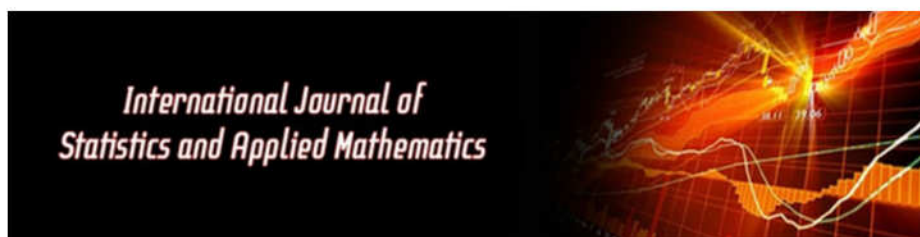

When Mathematics Meets History, Codes Begin to Speak

Two Grade XII students, Yug Prajapati and Raihan Dayma of Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad explored the fascinating world of cryptanalysis through their research on the legendary Enigma Machine.

Under the mentorship of Ms. Sabita Routroy, their paper on classical Polish cryptanalytic methods was published in the International Journal of Statistics and Applied Mathematics (2026).



A mathematical cryptanalytic investigation of the enigma machine using classical polish methods

Abstract

The Enigma machine, widely employed for secure military communication during the Second World War, is often cited as one of the most sophisticated cryptographic devices of the pre-digital era. This study presents a mathematically grounded cryptanalytic investigation of the Enigma system, focusing on the permutation structure, keyspace magnitude, and procedural vulnerabilities that enabled its eventual compromise. Using classical Polish cryptanalytic techniques namely the Grill Method, Zygalski Sheets, and the Polish Bomba this research analytically reconstructs the reduction of Enigma's vast theoretical keyspace into a tractable computational problem.

To empirically validate these methods, digital simulations of the Enigma M3 machine were employed, allowing controlled experimentation across thousands of encrypted message indicators. The results demonstrate that despite Enigma's enormous combinatorial complexity, predictable operational practices and structural constraints substantially weakened its security. The study further highlights the foundational role of permutation theory, combinatorics, and algorithmic reasoning in modern cryptanalysis. Beyond its historical significance, this work illustrates how classical mathematical techniques continue to inform contemporary cybersecurity education and cryptographic analysis.

Ten students. One street play. One important message.

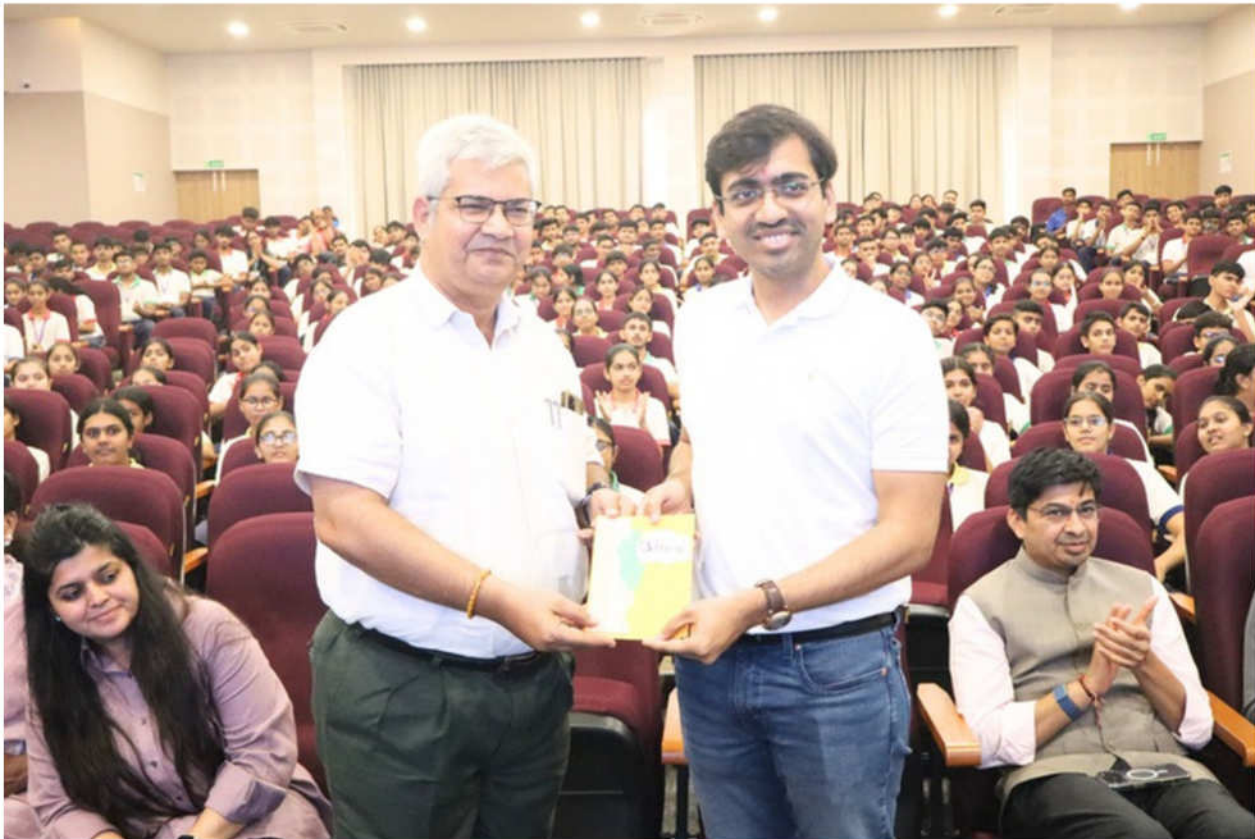
At the Inter-School Nukkad Natak Competition in Kota, students of Dav ACC Public School, Lakheri used theatre to speak about bullying and its impact.

Sometimes, one conversation is enough to make a young mind look beyond the horizon.



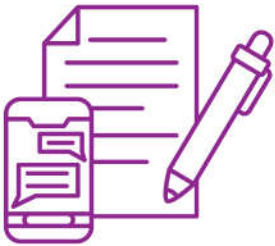
