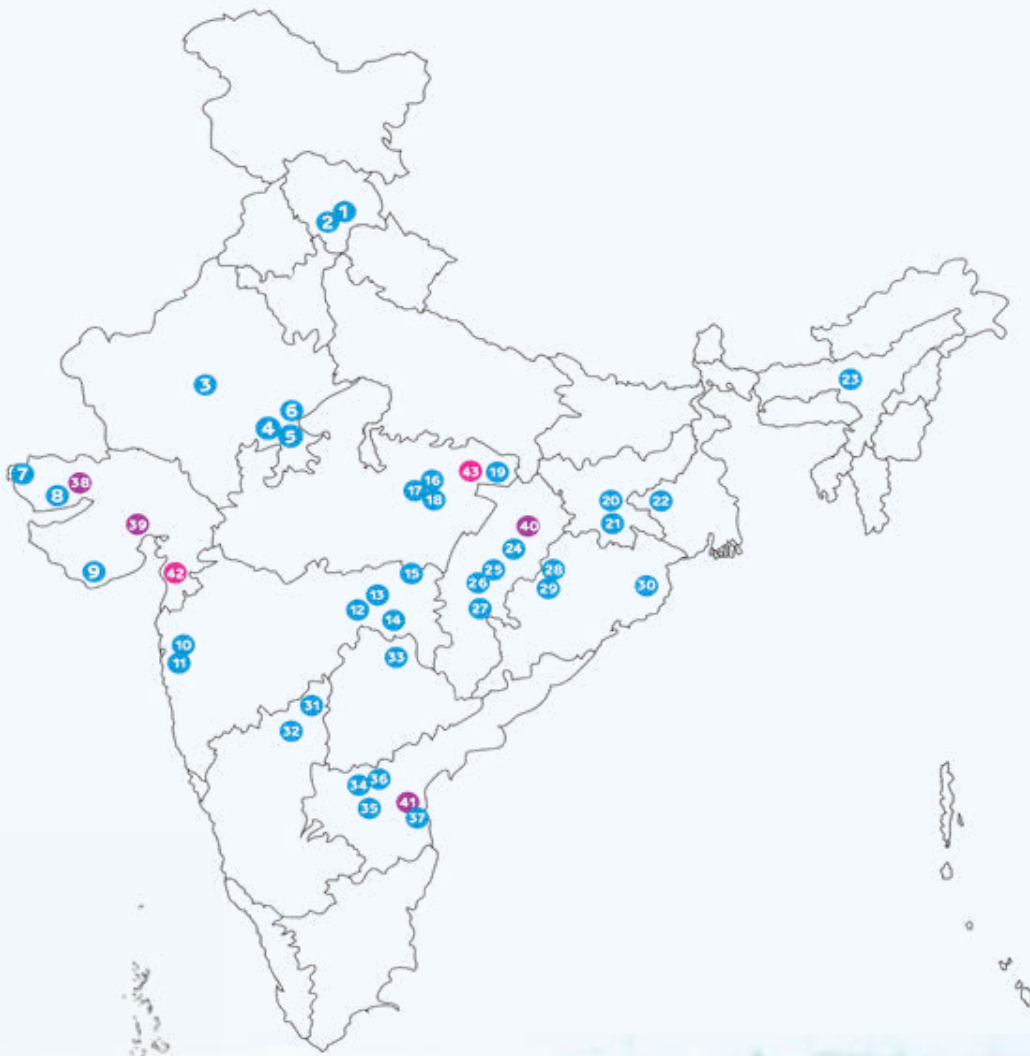

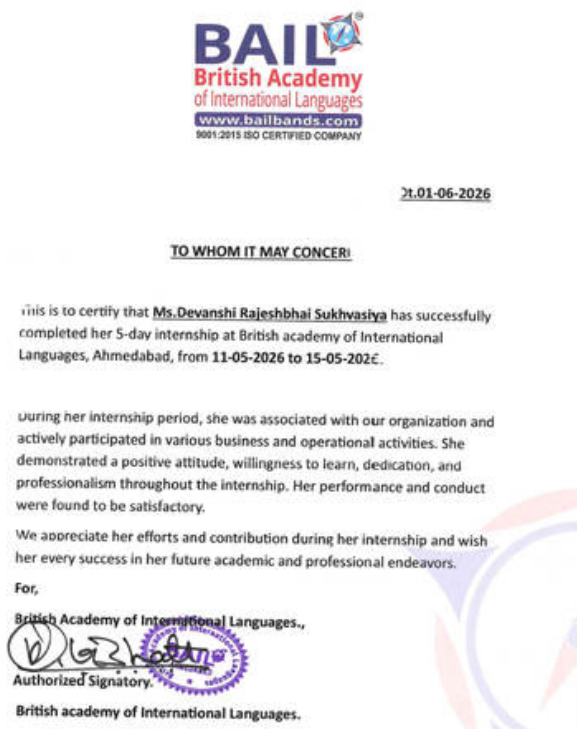
Discovering the World of Work

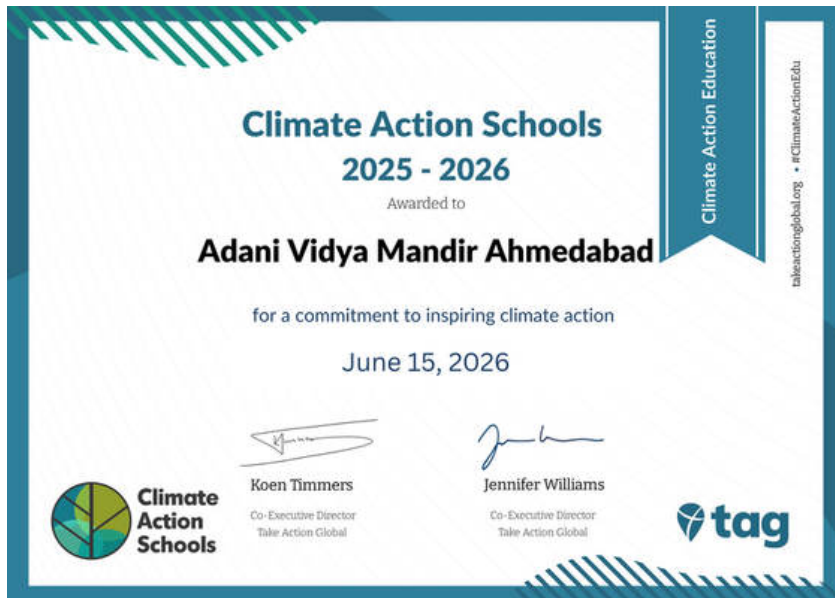

Teachers' Corner

Reviving Roots



What does it mean to create classrooms that are both future-ready and deeply rooted in India's civilizational wisdom?

This question guided a four-day **Capacity Building Programme on Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS)** held in Ahmedabad from June 5-8, 2026, bringing together educators from Adani Schools across the country.

The programme provided an opportunity for teachers to explore India's rich intellectual traditions and understand their relevance in contemporary education. Through reflective discussions on culture, languages, traditions, and indigenous ways of knowing, participants gained a deeper appreciation of IKS as a holistic and evolving system grounded in interconnectedness, observation, and coexistence.

Educators engaged with concepts such as Shreyas and Preyas, systems thinking, and multiple perspectives, encouraging them to re-examine classroom practices through a broader and more contextual lens. Practical frameworks including Aditi–Bodh–Abhyas–Prayog–Prasar, Panchapadi, and Pramanas helped translate these ideas into meaningful pedagogical approaches.

The programme concluded with collaborative lesson design and presentations, demonstrating how Indian knowledge traditions can be thoughtfully integrated across subjects.



Teachers' Corner

The Expressive Classroom



Effective teaching goes beyond delivering content, it involves engaging minds, nurturing confidence, and creating meaningful learning experiences. With this vision, Adani Foundation, in collaboration with InterAct, organised a **three-day professional development programme titled The Expressive Classroom from May 30 to June 01, 2026 in Ahmedabad.**

Facilitated by experts Mr. Craig Dequadros and Ms. Pakhi Bajaj, the workshop introduced educators to the transformative potential of Drama in Education (DiE). Through storytelling, improvisation, mime, speech, role play, voice modulation, phonetics, and stagecraft, participants explored innovative ways to make learning more engaging and student-centred.

A key focus of the programme was helping teachers develop strong communication skills through voice projection, articulation, body language, eye contact, and expressive presence. Experiential activities such as JAM sessions, simulations, collaborative tasks, and performance-based exercises encouraged spontaneity, creativity, and teamwork.

The workshop also highlighted the importance of emotionally safe classrooms where trust, inclusion, and risk-taking support deeper learning. By integrating drama techniques into curriculum planning and classroom practice, educators discovered new ways to strengthen student engagement, communication, confidence, and creativity. The programme concluded with collaborative presentations and implementation plans, equipping participants with practical strategies to bring expressive, experiential learning into their classrooms.



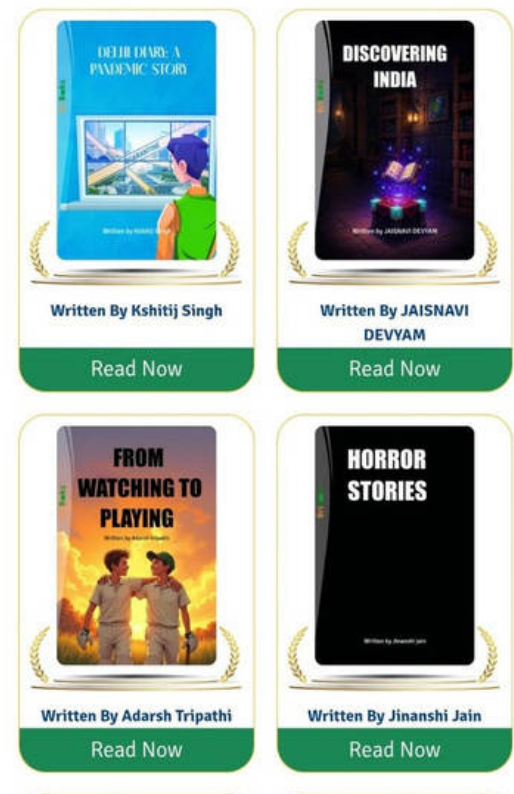
Research, Publications and Books

Each book offers a unique glimpse into the thoughts, perspectives, and creativity of its young author. Through the process of writing, editing, and publishing, students developed not only their language and communication skills but also confidence, perseverance, and self-expression.

More than a literary accomplishment, the experience encouraged students to discover the joy of writing and the power of their own voice.



STEMinIndia by Adani Foundation in collaboration with NIE, Singapore



The STEM Learning Journey, Round 2, an ambitious initiative of Adani Foundation in collaboration with NIE Singapore, is redefining how students learn by transforming classrooms into hubs of innovation, exploration, and purposeful problem-solving. Now spanning schools across multiple states, the programme has trained 349 teachers from 49 schools, equipping them to foster inquiry-driven, hands-on learning that nurtures creativity, collaboration, and scientific thinking.



Across Adani Schools, students are addressing real-world challenges through innovative STEM solutions. At Adani Public School, Mundra, learners developed a device that detects pesticide contamination in food using colour indicators, promoting safer and healthier communities. Students of Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad designed an affordable water filtration system to improve access to clean drinking water, while others created a Train Accident Preventer using sensor technology and a Smart Cooling Helmet to enhance safety and comfort in extreme temperatures.



Innovation extended to environmental sustainability as students at Ambuja Vidya Niketan, Ambujanagar explored solutions to reduce urban heat, and learners at Adani Vidya Mandir, Bhadreshwar engineered a desalination model to address water scarcity. At NRC School, Kalyan, immersive biodiversity experiences nurtured environmental stewardship, while Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad showcased creativity through sustainability-themed board games integrating product design, robotics, artificial intelligence, and responsible living.



These initiatives exemplify the Adani Foundation's vision of developing future-ready learners who think critically, innovate responsibly, and apply knowledge to create meaningful, sustainable solutions for society.



Designing for a Sustainable Future



Innovation becomes truly meaningful when it encourages learners to think beyond problems and design solutions that create positive impact. As part of the year-long **Design & Technology – Game on Sustainability** programme, students of **Adani Vidya Mandir Ahmedabad** embarked on an enriching journey that combined creativity, technology, and purpose-driven learning.

The programme culminated in the presentation of three student-designed board games, **Wellness Quest, Noble Frontiers United, and Nutrition Chaser**. Developed by 13 young innovators, these games explored themes of health, well-being, responsible decision-making, and sustainable living, transforming complex ideas into engaging learning experiences.

Drawing upon their understanding of Product Design, CAD-CAM, Robotics, Artificial Intelligence, and sustainability, students worked collaboratively to conceptualize, design, test, and refine their creations. The projects reflected not only technical knowledge but also empathy, creativity, critical thinking, and a strong awareness of contemporary challenges.
