
Foreword

Shining Through Strength Achievements in Martial Arts and Kickboxing


Students of Shram Niketan School, Jamul, run by the Adani Foundation, displayed outstanding discipline, determination, and sportsmanship at various state-level competitions.



Key elements of Utthan include making learning joyful, providing necessary resources and facilities, fostering literacy, numeracy and life skills and building teachers' capacities. Special emphasis is placed on nurturing Priya Vidyarthis and celebrating their progress. The initiative also strengthens government primary schools to make them a preferred choice for lower-middle-class families seeking quality education for their children.
